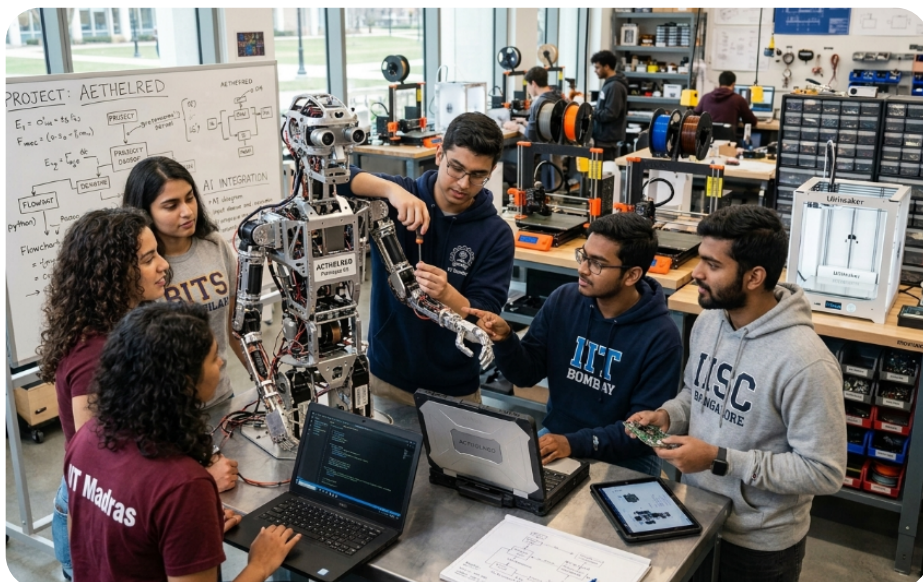

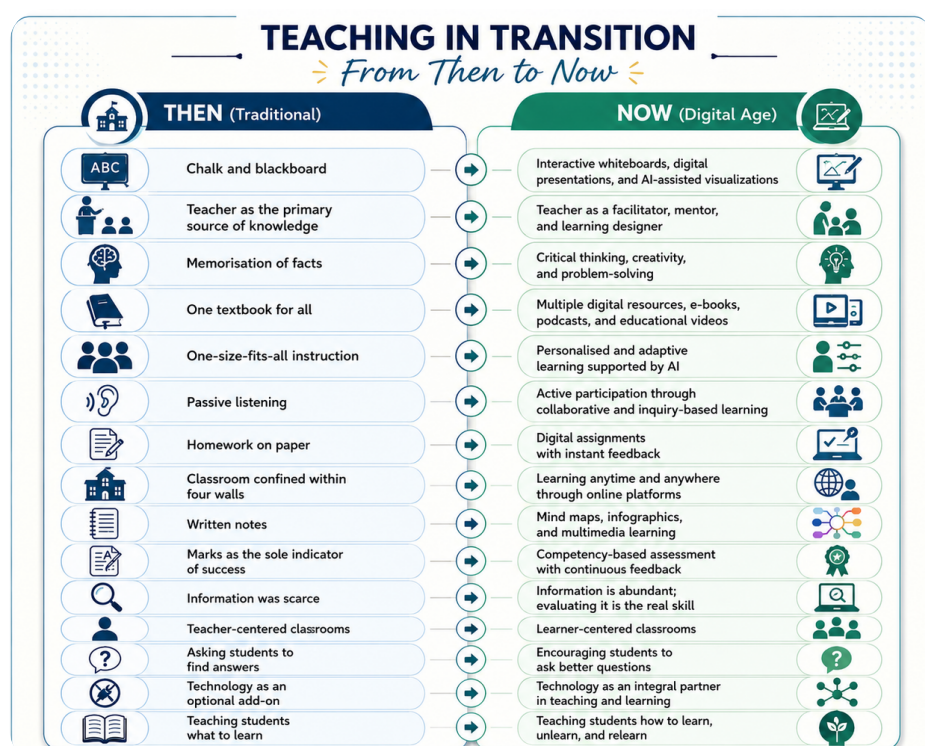
At IAEPT, we believe that teachers are not merely educators—they are nation builders.
